



Rate adjustments:

This project will be administered through the Town's Water Fund. There are no current user charges directly for non-potable water.

This is based on a 30-year loan with an interest rate of 1.6% with the CWCB. Based on 549 active customers, the annual debt cost per user per month is \$1.29. This final rate increase will be based on the actual loan amount, along with the interest rate on the loan which will be determined at the time of the loan application. Another potential option will be the Town starting to charge the school for the non-potable water usage.

Project timeframe may change based on the approval process from the various agencies.
