- 1. Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.
- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.
- 3. Roll Call took place with council members present, Buford, Kurtz, Pepper, Romero, Smith, Barber, Town Administrator Karen Gates, Town Clerk Scarlett Markus
